1) Member Contribution. I agree to pay to the Collective a Membership Fee (see current rate on website) each month (10% discount) for advanced yearly payment, as consideration for receipt of a Membership, issued to (individual named in agreement form on GLOW4GOOD membership club website) me by the Collective in accordance with the Articles and Bylaws. I also agree to provide my professional services on a volunteer basis during limited, scheduled time slots, as mutually determined by the Board and me, in support of GLOW4GOOD's overall mission.

I understand that my membership is not transferable. I agree to not transfer my membership.

2) Membership Eligibility: I agree to patronize the Collective through provision of my volunteering time and, during the period of my membership, to satisfy the eligibility criteria for members determined in accordance with the Articles and Bylaws.

3) Termination. I agree that, upon the voluntary or involuntary termination of my participation and membership in the Collective, I will transfer my membership certificate and card back to the Collective for the consideration, if any. Determined in accordance with the Articles and Bylaws. I understand that such consideration may be made over a specific period of time, determined by the board of directors in accordance with the Articles and Bylaws.

4) Withdrawal. I understand that I may at any time withdraw my participation and terminate my membership in the Collective; provided, however, that I agree to be bound by any terms and conditions in the Articles, the Bylaws, the operating rules, or this agreement.

Membership Agreement

GLOW4GOOD is a membership collective whose mission is to serve individuals and special groups within communities throughout the nation and abroad by hosting special events, one-on-one sessions, group workshops, and receptions, and to serve as a resource to clients and members.

GLOW4GOOD and its members collaborate to foster trusted partnerships between industry leaders, notable individuals, and corporations to develop positive relationships without favoring any particular brand or company. Our transparent annual dues and clear governance policy help us develop an industry-wide perspective.

Members are encouraged to attend the collective's "virtual" and in person meetings and approach the advisory council and organization leaders to share new ideas, topics, and issues that may concern them. GLOW4GOOD may exclude or expel a member who attempts to circumvent the governance process in an attempt to undermine our mission or promote dissatisfaction among the membership to recruit members to join a competing organization.

The Application Specifics:

All applications will be considered objectively and include access to due process to appeal any declined decision.

Applications may be rejected for the following reasons:

Applicants provided erroneous or incomplete information.

Applicants are not qualified, including:

Applicants have violated the association's Code of Conduct, Terms of Service, or Membership Agreement.

Accurate Information and Fair Dues

To join our collective, we require that you or an authorized representative of the Applicant, and not a proxy for someone unqualified, fill out an application that requires disclosure of your professional experience and credentials, specifically where you fit into our structure. We do this to maintain a collective that genuinely represents professionals in the beauty, fashion, and image styling industry. We may also compare your answer with public information. The application also allows us to better understand your talents, expertise, and interests in being a member, so we can ensure you'll get the most out of our charitable work and positive community building.

For associate membership an application is required for all new and renewing members.

High Standards

To maintain high standards and ensure that our members have verified credentials, we require the disclosure of basic information while complying with all anti-discrimination and antitrust laws.

All member companies must fill out an application.

Do You Own or Represent Other Businesses / Organizations?

If you represent other businesses beyond your above-mentioned role, we require disclosure about those other businesses to understand how you fit into the association. For example, we generally avoid businesses whose representatives seek to join to gain access to solicit other members. If you represent a services firm or an association, as mentioned above, or a product specifically designed for customers (tech companies) that overlap with our membership, your application may not be approved. If you intend to approach GLOW4GOOD members on behalf of another organization to solicit participation in external activities, such as competing events, meetings, or marketing content creation, or engage in policy or advocacy discussions that conflict with our policy advocacy, your application may not be approved. Generally, if your public profile reflects multiple roles, affiliations, or business interests, GLOW4GOOD may ask for additional context about those relationships and consider the full scope of your professional activities in evaluating your application, including whether any such affiliations fall outside the categories of membership we approve.

Competing Events and Activities

Occasionally, member companies host their own events or participate in activities that compete or conflict with association activities or advocacy. For example, a member company may host a reception or forum sponsored by related industry organizations, including association members, in a proximate timeframe or on the same day at a nearby location of an association event, which relies on the support and participation of the GLOW4GOOD member collective. In cases where a member company hosts a competing event or organizes a competing activity that involves the participation of other GLOW4GOOD member collective, the member organization may be excluded from the planning and/or participation of the association's competing activities, including event planning, committees, and working groups, to avoid undermining our collective efforts. In such cases, the association is under no obligation to publicize or promote the competing event. Annual Agreement

All agreements are for a one-year annual membership, dues are paid either monthly or annually (with a 10% discount rate) Membership applications and renewals are subject to approval by the advisory council.

Participation in committees by member organizations (not including associate members) includes opportunities for collaboration. The advisory council and various committees are established to guide association activities and programs. Members must be current with their dues to vote on association business or receive member rates for events and sponsorships.

On occasion, at the request of committee co-chairs, a committee meeting may be open to governance staff and non-member participants.

GLOW4GOOD members voted to establish a certification program to demonstrate members and affiliate organizations experience working as industry professionals who representing brands, are independent contractors, or associated with the industry. This includes a minimum requirement for at least 5 years in business, at least 5 years working as a contractor, 10 or more contract engagements, or projects within the past two years.

Individuals and organizations that do not qualify may join as associate members and participate in the association's mentorship program for startups.

GLOW4GOOD does not allow entities to join the collective as a way of soliciting members for the sale of products or consulting services, such as business development, or marketing, or to recruit them for external activities that may conflict or compete with its rules or policy agenda.

GLOW4GOOD does not sell data to third parties or share event registration lists with event sponsors or attendees.

As a member benefit, we will publish company information in the private GLOW4GOOD membership directory. Read our privacy policy.

GLOW4GOOD strictly complies with all antitrust laws. All GLOW4GOOD members and staff will be sensitive to the unique legal issues involving trade associations.

Access to members-only online tools, such as Insight, is restricted to those with authorized access, including employees of the member organizations who pay dues, as referenced above. The sharing of login and account information, and proprietary member content, is strictly prohibited and may result in the suspension or cancellation of member benefits for individuals and/or companies without a refund.

Privacy Policy

General

GLOW4GOOD ("G4GCLUB," "we," "us" or "our") strongly believes in protecting the privacy and integrity of personally identifiable information gathered from visitors to our websites, including glow4good.club and glow4good.com (collectively, the "Site"). The protection of your privacy is of the greatest importance to us. This Privacy Policy sets

forth how we protect the personal information that you supply voluntarily when you use the Site and any other services we offer and describes the choices you have concerning such information. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully.

This Privacy Policy incorporates our Terms of Use; any capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy have the meanings given to them in our Terms of Use. We may need to change this Privacy Policy from time to time in order to address new issues and reflect changes to the Site. We will post changes here so that you know what information we gather, how we might use that information, and whether we will disclose that information to anyone. Changes and modifications to this Privacy Policy will be effective immediately upon our posting of the changes and modification on the Site, except where prohibited by law. Your Device characteristics; and

Certain other Device data, including the time of day you access the Site and other Usage Information

c. Cookies and Similar Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on the Site. Cookies are files with a small amount of data, which may include unique identifiers, and are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your device. We also use other tracking technologies, such as beacons, tags and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our Site.

a. Cookies

Cookies on the Site generally fall into the following categories:

Strictly Necessary Cookies: These are required for the operation of the Site. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas. These cookies are session cookies that are erased when you close your browser.

Analytical/Performance Cookies: These allow us to recognize and count the number of users of the Site and see how such users navigate through the Site. This helps improve how the Site works, for example, by ensuring that users can find what they are looking for easily. These cookies are session cookies that are erased when you close your browser.

Functional Cookies: These improve the functional performance of the Site and make it easier for you to use. For example, cookies are used to remember that you have previously visited the Site and asked to remain logged into it. These cookies are session cookies that are erased when you close your browser.

Advertising Cookies: These record your visits to the Site, the pages you visit and the links you follow so we can recognize you and track your activity on the Site and other websites you visit. These cookies are persistent cookies because they remain on your device for us to use during your next visit to the Site. You can delete these cookies via your browser settings.

3. Personal Information We Share with Third Parties

We may share personal information collected via the Site in the following ways.

a. Credit Card Donations

Donations you make to GLOW4GOOD are processed exclusively by our third-party payment

processor, **Classy**. **Classy** is committed to providing safe, secure and private online transactions. Credit card numbers are fully encrypted after a donation has been processed and are not retained in GLOW4GOOD's electronic or hard files. For further details about Classy's privacy practices and security precautions, please consult the privacy policy directly from the link on our donation page.

When you make a donation to us through the "Donate" button on our Site, **Classy** shares your Personal Information with GLOW4GOOD so we or **Classy** may acknowledge receipt of your donation for tax purposes and, unless you ask us not to, include you on GLOW4GOOD's mailing list.

If you do not wish to be added to our mailing list, our online donation form has an "opt-in" mechanism that can be unchecked for those users who wish to make donations but do not want to receive any additional email correspondence from GLOW4GOOD. You may also make donations anonymously by checking this preference on the donation page. Donors may request removal of personally identifiable information from our databases by contacting us at the phone number or email address listed below. To honor requests, we will need the exact information to be removed and information sufficient for us to identify the type of communication received from us.

When you send a donation in honor or in memory of someone and request that an acknowledgment be sent to another individual/family, we will use the name and address of that individual/family for acknowledgment purposes only.

b. Our Service Providers

We will share your Personal Information with **Classy** and our other third-party service providers, as described above; with respect to other third-parties, we will only share your identifiable Personal Information with your express permission, or if we are required by law to do so.

c. When You Request Information From or Provide Information to Third Parties

Please be aware that our site contains links to other web sites. G4G cannot control and is not responsible for the content or the privacy policies of those websites. This Privacy Policy does not apply to any web pages not under a domain owned and operated by GMHC, regardless of any hyperlinks from a web page under our domains to external web pages. We advise you to check their privacy policies as well.

d. For Legal Purposes

We may also share your Personal Information with any legal and government regulatory authorities in response to their request for information or to assist in investigations. We may also disclose your Personal Information to third parties in connection with claims, disputes or litigation, or when otherwise required by law or to protect our legal rights.

e. To Protect Our Rights and The Rights of Others

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, we may also disclose your Personal Information if we believe in good faith that doing so is necessary or appropriate to: (i) protect or defend our rights, safety or property of us or third parties (including through the enforcement of this Privacy Policy and other applicable agreements and policies); or (ii) comply with legal and regulatory obligations (e.g., pursuant to law enforcement inquiries, subpoenas, or court orders). To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, we have complete discretion in electing to make or not make such disclosures, and to contest or not contest requests for such disclosures, all without notice to you.

4. Exercising Choices and Preferences
